At the Glenwood Springs Mission there was one healing after another. We could not but lay hands on someone and that person was not healed. Please visit my website to see a young boy who Nick prayed with. The boy was blind in the right eye and is now seeing. We saw backs healed, frozen

shoulders released, and pain instantly gone. In one case, a man came forward who had a continual sore throat with an issue of blood in his spittle that the doctors could not explain. After prayer, the pain and the blood were gone. There was a little girl who could not hear out of her left ear. After prayer, in the name of the Jesus, her hearing was completely restored.

Another great gift of the Glenwood Mission was that of the Anglo and the Hispanic community coming together. This was the first time that they came together at this magnitude.

“I attended a parish mission led by Brendan at St. Thomas More in Centennial Colorado and I can only describe it as life changing. As Brendan spoke in his powerful, open, vulnerable way, my heart was moved and opened. I began to hear God's voice in a new way. My relationship with Jesus has grown into one that I have desired and pursued for years, but until now, I have always fallen back into my old comfort zones or bad habits. This powerful week taught me to pray more! And when I say more, I mean, almost all the time. I believe a healing in our marriage took place during the mission and I'm so excited to see where our relationship goes. Our 10 year old son has been changed since the mission as well. Not only has his prayer life grown, but his passion for the Catholic Church and his interest in Mass. Our family was transformed during the parish mission and I cannot say enough about it. My hope is that Brendan, who is clearly in touch with the Holy Spirit will have the opportunity to go to more communities and change more lives, one family at a time!
